

INDIAN ROCKS POOL POLICY

9/19/22

The following rules and regulations apply to the Indian Rocks Community Pool.

1. The pool is “swim at your own risk”. The use of the pool facilities is at your own risk. Indian Rocks is not responsible for any accidents/injuries occurring on the premises.
2. The current year’s Indian Rocks wristbands must be displayed at the pool. If guests would like to purchase day passes, a minimum of one person in the party must display a current year’s Indian Rocks wristband and the remainder of the guests may purchase a day pass. Day passes are available at the pool for \$5 per adult, \$2 per child aged 3-12 years, and children under the age of 3 years are free. **Everyone over the age of 3 entering the pool facility must have a current I.R. wristband or guest pass.** Property Owners can purchase additional seasonal bands at the Indian Rocks Office for \$20 each.
3. Everyone must sign-in at the pool with their Indian Rocks address.
4. All cars and golf carts/UTVs in the parking areas of the pool must be parked in the appropriately labeled parking areas and display a current Indian Rocks sticker or vehicle tag.

POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

Rules and Regulations are posted at the pool. These rules and regulations are enforced by the pool attendants and are upheld by the Indian Rocks Board of Directors and Community Management. Any violations of pool rules and regulations, inappropriate behavior, or disrespect of pool attendants may result in removal from the pool area, fines, and/or loss of future pool privileges.

Pool attendants have full discretion to close the pool in the interest of health and safety.

1. No pets or animals, except for registered service animals, of any kind are allowed at or in the vicinity of the pool (PA Department of Environmental Protection regulation).

2. No glass containers are permitted on the pool grounds.
3. All trash must be placed in appropriate receptacles.
4. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on the pool grounds.
5. No food or beverages are permitted in the pool.
6. Smoking is prohibited on the pool grounds.
7. Persons with infections or diseases that may be transmitted by water, including open wounds, are prohibited from using the pool.
8. No children under the age of 14 are to be left unattended at the pool grounds. Anyone under the age of 14 must be accompanied by someone 16 years of age or older.
9. Individual sized soft pool toys, balls, and flotation devices (i.e., tubes and noodles) are permitted at the Pool Attendant's discretion. Water guns or any type of water shooters are prohibited.
10. No jumping or diving into the pool is permitted, including flips, dives, or other stunts.
11. No sitting or pulling on the pool rope.
12. No blocking the pool steps.
13. No use of personal sound emitting devices without headphones.
14. No running, jumping, or horseplay is permitted in the pool grounds.
15. The pool deck must be kept clear of all personal items at all times.
16. Clothing other than bathing suits and/or appropriate swimwear are not to be worn in the pool.
17. Any children not yet full potty trained must wear appropriate swim diapers in the pool.
18. Any accidents at the pool should be reported immediately to the Pool attendant.
19. Entering pool grounds when it is closed will result in a fine and loss of pool rights and possible prosecution.
